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1. When does this privacy statement apply?

It applies to personal processing data collected through the Stable.com Website or when you contact us via the channels available to you such as email, phone, inquiry form, social media links or App stores (iOS or Android) (collectively referred to as "Website").

2. For which purposes do we process your personal data?

1. For the technical and functional management of the Website.

We will collect certain technical information, like the IP-address of your device, the webpages you visit, previous/next visited websites, the duration of a session, and the country you chose when landing on our Website is usually processed by us, your login information, the browser type and version, the time zone setting, device language, the operating system and platform, the type of device you use, whether your device uses a virtual private network (VPN), a unique device identifier (for example, your device's IMEI number, or the mobile phone number used by the device), mobile network information, your mobile operating system and the type of mobile browser you use.

2. To answer questions and to communicate with you

3. Who has access to your personal data?

Access to your personal data by the Stable.com Providers

Personal data we collect may be transferred internationally (also outside the European Economic Area) across the Unlimit Group. Employees in the group are authorised to access your personal data only to the extent necessary to serve the applicable purposes we describe above and to perform their jobs.

Access to your personal data by third parties

When third parties are given access to your personal data, we will take the required contractual, technical and organisational measures to ensure that your personal data are only processed to the extent that such processing is necessary. The third parties will only process your personal data per applicable law.

In that case, we will take measures to ensure that your personal data are adequately protected, such as entering into EU Standard Contractual Clauses with these third parties.
